



# Guidelines for Separation & Disposing of Household Rubbish

All garbage must be placed at your collection site by 8:00 a.m. on collection day!

## Burnable Garbage

Twice a Week

Wed & Sat every week

They must be placed in Mishima City garbage bags.



- Please use a garbage bag specified by Mishima City.
- Garbage must be drained off any excess water.
- Cooking oil must be soaked up with paper, cloth etc, for dispose.
- Plastic and vinyl products, such as videotapes and cassette tapes etc, are "Burnable Garbage."
- Wood pieces/tree branches of a length less than 50 cm and must be in small bundles.

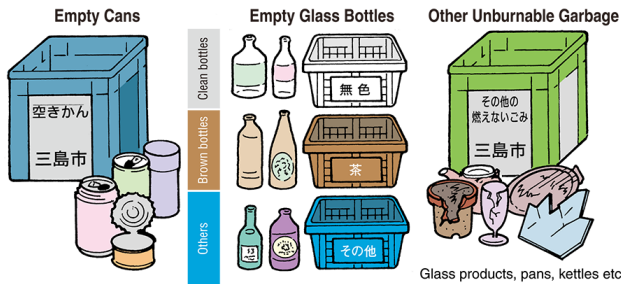

## Recyclable Refuse

Twice a Month

1st & 3rd Fri

They must be placed in the designated containers at collection sites.



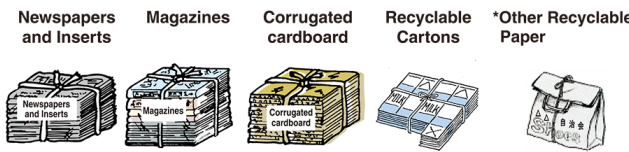
- Empty and rinse with water. Place them into the designated containers at collecting sites.
- Crush empty cans as much as possible.
- Remove the caps of the bottles.
  - Plastic caps are "Burnable Garbage."
  - Place the metal caps into the container of "Other Unburnable."
- Place the broken bottles and cosmetic bottles in a container of "Other Unburnable."
- Remove your wastes from a bag, etc., and put it in the container provided at the collection site. (Take back home the bag in which you bring cans and bottles.)

## Recyclable Paper

Twice a Month

2nd & 4th Fri



- Sort the paper and tie them both ways around the middle and length with white paper string.
- Should be flattered to maximum size of 50cm<sup>2</sup>.
- Wash milk cartons and other beverage cartons clean. Cut them open, and dry them. Then bundle them, and take them to the collection site.

- If papers get wet, it will not be able to be recycled, so if it rains, collection will be postponed to the following collection day.
- Newspapers and inserts must be tied together.
- **Other Recyclable Paper**
- Cartons, pasteboards, paper cups, wrapping paper, postcards, etc.
- The following paper cannot be accepted as "Other Recyclable Paper": Paper soaked in oil or water, paper coated with aluminum or vinyl, photographs
- **(Recyclable Cartons)**
- Cartons which have aluminum in it are "Burnable Garbage."
- Remove any plastic packaging.

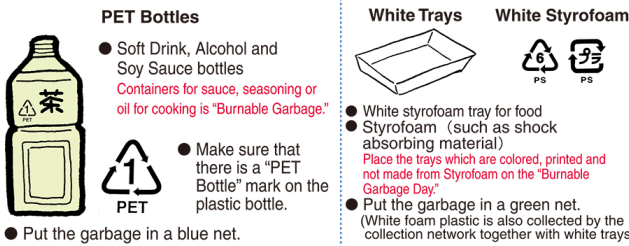

## PET (Plastic) Bottles-White Trays

Twice a Month

2nd & 4th Fri

They must be Placed in the designated containers at the collection sites.



- **PET Bottles**
- Soft Drink, Alcohol and Soy Sauce bottles
- Containers for sauce, seasoning or oil for cooking is "Burnable Garbage."
- Make sure that there is a "PET Bottle" mark on the plastic bottle.
- Put the garbage in a blue net.

- **White Trays**
- **White Styrofoam**
- White styrofoam tray for food
- Styrofoam (such as shock absorbing material)
- Place the trays which are colored, printed and not made from Styrofoam on the "Burnable Garbage Day."
- Put the garbage in a green net. (White foam plastic is also collected by the collection network together with white trays.)

- **(PET Bottles)**
- Anything left inside them must be removed. Then rinse them thoroughly. After drying them, crush them with your foot.
- Remove the caps of the bottles.
- **(White Trays)**
- Wash them clean. After drying them, take them to the collection site.
- Get rid of the tape and wrap.

## Hazardous Garbage

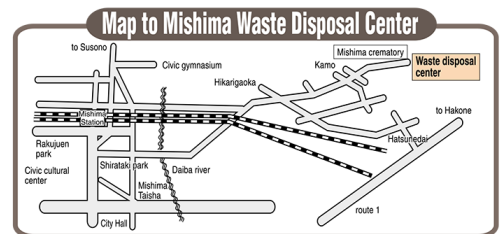
Once a Month

2nd Friday every month

They must be placed into the semi-transparent bags.



- Empty aerosol cans/spray cans and pierce a hole in the bottom.



## Large-sized Garbage

Please take large-sized garbage directly to the Mishima Waste Disposal Center  
Earth and sand, stones, concrete blocks, construction scraps, motorbikes, tires, car batteries, agricultural machinery, agricultural chemicals, propane gas tanks, fire extinguishers, pianos, fire-resistant safes  
There is a thing which cannot perform a receipt.

Furniture-Electric appliances (except televisions, air conditioners, refrigerators and washing machines)



- **Office open**
- Monday through Friday (Weekday) or the first Sunday of every month.
- [Morning] from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
- [Afternoon] from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

\*We are going to check your address, so please bring your ID with your current address.

Bicycles-Oil stoves etc.



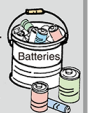
Home appliances eligible for recycling. Televisions, air-conditioners, refrigerators, washing machines. Personal computers.



- Cannot be processed at the sanitation center.
- Arrange for them to be picked up by the retailer from which they were originally purchased.

## Batteries

- There is no designated collection day. Put them anytime.
- Put them into a designated box placed at collecting sites.
- Take Button-shaped mercury cells and Nickel-cadmium batteries back to the retailer.
